Appetite to explore a unique service & the population it serves

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'I wanted to get an idea of how those vulnerable pockets of society did interact with the health service' (P5)

Perceived lack of exposure personally


Perceived lack of exposure personally

'Medical school is a certain type of pupil and I think it is really important to break out of that... So I think quite often people can come into med school and not have, unless they have an interest and have actively volunteered somewhere, they won't necessarily have an insight into the deprivation' (P2)


Perceived lack of exposure professionally

Change in perception / perspective

'I think it's something that everybody should have to experience because it does just **broaden your horizons** so much with regards to..just.. what you think of these people' (P8)

'It was really **eye-opening** ...just sitting in a room with all of these people who actually are very normal and very like everyone else' (P3)

'I have always wanted to be a GP but it has made me far more passionate about becoming a GP and maybe getting more involved in kind of advocacy, public health' (P1)

Future Plans

'So I did go away thinking... damn if I become an anaesthetist I'm going to get so buried in these people's medical stuff that I am going to miss all this social stuff' (P4)
